Nomination and Eligibility

1. No horse which has raced at a registered race meeting or taken part in an official barrier trial since 29 September 2016 or which has been in the care of a licensed trainer at any time within a period of 2 years immediately prior to the meeting, may enter the Pride of the West.
2. Nomination fee is \$30 per horse which will include rider insurance. This is to be forwarded with the nomination forms before the closing date.
3. The committee reserves the right to refuse any nomination.
4. The rider must be at least 18 years of age, be a competent rider and have the ability to control the horse they choose to ride.
5. No present jockeys are eligible to ride in the Pride of the West.

Riding and Race Day Conduct

1. All horses will be ridden at catch weights.
2. No whips may be used.
3. All riders must wear approved helmets which conform to Australian Safety Standards and appropriate boots
4. There will be no more than 12 horses in each race and no horse will race more than one heat.
5. Races will consist of 4 x 250 metre heats, with the first two place getters to compete in the final, the **Pride of the West**. The committee reserves the right to increase or decrease race numbers in response to nominations.
6. All horses and equipment to be in sound condition, and the responsibility of the owner and rider. To ensure safety, unruly or uncontrollable horses will be scratched and removed from the track.
7. All races will be hanky-drop starts.
8. Only stock saddles with breastplates may be used. Track work or exercise racing style pads may not be used, irrespective of their weight.
9. No rider shall wear any apparel or use any equipment, which has not been approved by the club. The wearing of race colours e.g. station colours is encouraged.
10. If horses have leg bandages for racing, all loose ends to be tucked in and bandages to be stitched. Insulation tape is not sufficient.
11. The Course Animal Welfare Officer has sole discretion as to the racing fitness of a horse and may withdraw any horse, if, in his/her opinion, it is not fit to race.
12. All horses must return to the saddling paddock immediately after each race.
13. All riders are to attend a meeting at the marshalling yards at 12.30am on the day of the race meeting. This is compulsory. If a horse arrives late, refusal to race can occur.
14. The Committee reserves the right to refuse participation by any rider deemed to be affected by alcohol.
15. Swearing or obscene language will not be tolerated.
16. The Quilpie Diggers' Race Club reserves the right to conduct random testing on all horses for performance enhancing substances.
17. The judge's decision is final; no discussion will be entered into.
